- **A candidate is allowed to enroll in two academic programmes at the same time, with one being in full-time physical mode and the other in Open and Distance Learning (ODL) or Online mode. - (vi) It is for the information of one and all that Guru Nanak Dev University has no contract/lien with any private body/institution for admissions. The applicants are advised to fill in application forms themselves by logging in at <http://odl.gndu.ac.in/> . In case of any difficulty, staff may be contacted in the Centre for IT solutions of the University or Office of Directorate of Open & Distance Learning. There are no criteria, other than the one mentioned in the prospectus of the University, for getting admission to various courses.
- (vii) The University is conducting 10-12 **Personal Contact Programmes (PCP)** on weekends preferably in online mode however the student can come to contact GNDU Main Campus Amritsar to contact the course coordinator.
- (viii) Examination for all ODL classes will be conducted in offline mode as per the guidelines issued by the examination wing of the University. Examination centre for the offline examination for GNDU College Jalandhar, Pathankot and Nakodar students shall be same college and for students enrolled under Directorate of Open and Distance Learning GNDU Main Campus Amritsar and GNDU College Verka shall be any of the affiliated college(s) of GNDU in Amritsar District. The examinations will be conducted on any day(s) as per the datesheet issued by the examination wing.
- (ix) The University remains closed on Saturdays, Sundays and other gazetted holidays.

# *Guidelines for Application & Admission*

1. Admission to all the courses offered under Directorate of Open and Distance Learning, Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar at its Main Campus and Constituent Colleges, shall be made based on **Eligibility of Qualifying Examination**.
2. The student may be allowed to do two academic programmes simultaneously (one Degree programme and one Certificate/Diploma programme) from our University in all three modes, Regular/Online/ODL provided that the total credits of two programmes shall not exceed 40 per semester, while maintaining the minimum credit requirements of the individual programme [as per the Common Ordinances for programmes under Credit-Based Evaluation and Grading System (w.e.f Session 2025-26)].
3. There shall be no entrance test for any course under the ODL programme.
4. For course details, eligibility criteria, fee, and relative information click the appropriate section of this prospectus.
5. For admission the following steps are to be followed:

## **a. Creation of ABC ID (mandatory)**

**Step 01:** Visit the DigiLocker Portal at <https://www.digilocker.gov.in/>

Click on the “Sign in” button on the top corner, if you are a new user → click on the “Sign up” button

**Step 02:** Fill all the requisite information as asked and set six-digit login PIN for additional security → hit the submit button

• Enter the OTP that was sent to the registered mobile and hit the “Submit”

**Step 03:** Signout and Sign in to the DigiLocker portal by entering the registered credentials.

• Enter the registered mobile number, followed by security PIN → verify OTP will be prompted → enter the OTP and hit the “Submit” button

**Step 04:** Once logged in, under the home page ->click the “Join Now” button of the Academic Bank of Credits banner → ABC (APAAR) ID creation window will pop up

**Step 05** Enter the requisite details and hit the “Get Document” button

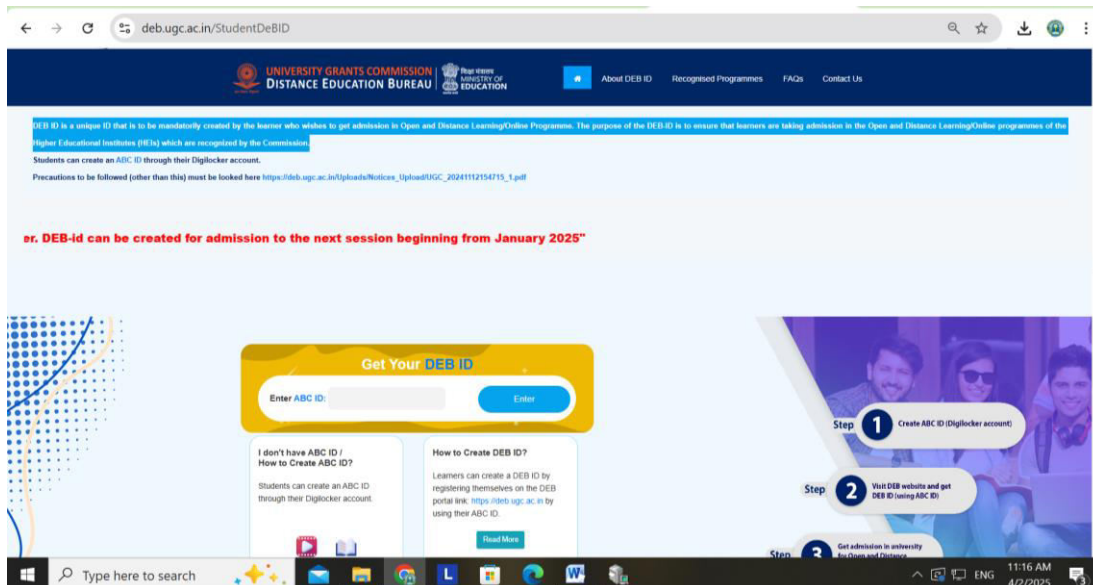

## **b. Creation of UGC DEB ID (mandatory)**

DEB ID is a unique ID that is to be mandatorily created by the learner who wishes to get admission in Open and Distance Learning/Online Programme. The purpose of the DEB-ID is to ensure that learners are taking admission in the Open and Distance Learning/Online programmes of the Higher Educational Institutes (HEIs) which are recognized by the Commission.

**c. Generation of login ID and password.**

#### Notes:

- Candidate after successful submission of application form on ODL website can visit to Directorate office at GNDU campus or any of the learning support centre(s) as specified in prospectus with original copy of above mentioned documents for on spot admission and paying the fee. Students can also attend the centralized counselling for taking the admission as per schedule specified on page no.48.
- Candidates, who have passed the qualifying examination from University/Institution other than GNDU, shall be required to submit a migration and eligibility certificate after admission as per university rules within a specified period.
- Candidates seeking admission in various courses under the ODL programme, who have passed their lower examination with lateral entry and distance education programme, will have to get an equivalency certificate from the University before finalizing the provisional admission.
- The courses of study, duration of courses, the medium of instruction and examination, mode of the examination unless otherwise specified, shall be the same as specified on ODL syllabus ([odl.gndu.ac.in](http://odl.gndu.ac.in)).
- The Courses under the Directorate of Open & Distance Learning will be governed by the University Ordinances for Open & Distance Learning Mode available on ODL website ([odl.gndu.ac.in](http://odl.gndu.ac.in)).
- Examination pattern is the **Credit Based Semester System** as per the University Ordinances for Open & Distance Learning (ODL) Mode.

- If the number of candidates seeking admission to a course is not adequate (minimum of 5 candidates in case of PG courses and 10 in case of UG courses) or due to administrative or other reasons, the University may decide not to offer the course. In this case, an application fee of Rs. 500/ Rs. 250 is not refundable and the remaining submitted fee is refundable as per University policy and rules.
- Personal Contact Programme and end-term theory examination will be as per the administrative decision of the University.

# *Refund of Fee & Security*

- 1) If a candidate does not join the course and surrenders the seat after getting admission but **before the last date of admission or commencement of PCP classes** (*whichever is earlier*), the fee and funds deposited by such a candidate will be refunded after deducting a processing charge of Rs. 2000/-.
- 2) A candidate, who joins the course/class, may be even for one day and surrenders the seat in writing, will be refunded tuition fee and funds after deducting fee and funds for three months.
- 3) Before the completion of the admission process, if a candidate is allowed to shift from one general course to another general course, for this purpose, the fee and funds deposited by him/her will be adjusted after charging Rs. 5000/- (for each shifting) as shifting fee. These rules will be applicable for University Campus, Regional Campuses, and constituent colleges.
- 4) If the number of candidates seeking admission to a course is not adequate (minimum of 30 candidates in case of UG/PG courses and 20 in case of Certificat/Diploma courses) or due to administrative or other reasons, the University may decide not to offer the course. In this case, an application fee of Rs. 500/Rs. 250 is not refundable, and the remaining submitted fee is refundable as per University policy and rules.
