1.6 Describe the mechanism implemented to ensure that the quality of ODL programmes matches with the quality of relevant programmes in conventional mode:

Presently, the Directorate is offering only those programmes, which are already being offered in the conventional mode by the HEI in either University Campus / Regional Campus(es) or its Constituent Colleges. Some of the programmes offered under ODL mode such as MA (ENG). MBA, B. Lib., MCA, etc. have been running successfully for more than 35 years in the conventional mode. Also, the Eligibility Criteria and Equivalency for these course(s), are the same, as applicable to the regular candidates seeking admission in University Campus / Regional Campus(es) or its Constituent Colleges, under Conventional Mode. Syllabi and strict quality control of examination and its related activities have not been compromised to ensure the quality of ODL programmes matches with relevant programmes offered in the conventional mode. The Directorate is also offering all its candidates the Library facility of the University. Recently, the Directorate has established 02 new Computer Labs along with 01 Multimedia Lab to provide better practical training to the Students. Students can also visit the Directorate office/University to avail the Library as well as Computer Lab facilities in any of the working days for their hands on training. We have offered many feasibilities to candidates of ODL mode but none to compromise the quality of study level.

In this meeting, members discussed about the features and functions of this Centre. Members also deliberated on primary focus, as to shoulder the responsibilities of generating and promoting awareness for quality assurance and to work out the procedural details.

In current session 2019-20, around 389 (fresh) candidates have been admitted and members were satisfied that Directorate has successfully uploaded all the requisite data on data-entry portal of UGC-DEB and as all the guidelines of UGC for ODL, are being followed and satisfied. Members also discussed about DPRs for different programme(s) being offered under ODL mode by Directorate of Open & Distance Learning, Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar and reviewed about the annual progress report for session 2018-19. The committee also reviewed the admission and examination system / pattern of Directorate, the examination process (setting of question paper, date-sheet and conduct of exams) is being handled by the Examination wing of HEI, similar to its courses running in conventional mode, however, Directorate is conducting exams mostly on Sundays and UGC-DEB guidelines for ODL, the scheme is under Credit Bases Semester System and the scheme is marginally different from courses running in conventional mode (Credit Based Evaluation and Grading System). Also, the syllabi are more than 80% same to that being offered in conventional mode (as per UGC-ODL guidelines).
