Presently, the Directorate is offering only those programmes, which are already being offered in the conventional mode by the HEI in either University Campus / Regional Campus(es) or its Constituent Colleges. Some of the programmes offered under ODL mode such as MA (ENG), MBA, B. Lib., MCA, etc. have been running successfully for more than 35 years in the conventional mode. Also, the Eligibility Criteria and Equivalency for these course(s), are the same, as applicable to the regular candidates seeking admission in University Campus / Regional Campus(es) or its Constituent Colleges, under Conventional Mode. Syllabi and strict quality control of examination and its related activities have not been compromised to ensure the quality of ODL programmes matches with relevant programmes offered in the conventional mode. The Directorate is also offering all its candidates the Library facility of the University. Recently, the Directorate has established 02 new Computer Labs along with 01 Multimedia Lab to provide better practical training to the Students. Students can also visit the Directorate office/University to avail the Library as well as Computer Lab facilities in any of the working days for their hands on training. We have offered many feasibilities to candidates of ODL mode but none to compromise the quality of study level.

About Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar

Guru Nanak Dev University was established at Amritsar on November 24, 1969 to mark the 500th birth anniversary of Sri Guru Nanak Dev Ji. It is both a residential and an affiliating university. In conceiving the future course of the University, the objectives enshrined in the Guru Nanak Dev University Act 1969, emphasized that the new University would make provision for imparting education and promoting research in the humanities, learned professions, sciences, especially of applied nature and technology

Ever since its foundation, the endeavor of the University has been to meet the objectives enshrined in the Guru Nanak Dev University Act 1969, which emphasized that the new University would make provisions for imparting education and promoting research in the humanities, learned professions, sciences, especially of applied nature and technology. Studies and research on the life and teaching of Guru Nanak Dev Ji, in addition to working towards the promotion of Punjabi language and imparting knowledge to educationally backward classes and communities, are the other commitments.

In consonance with these expectations, the University in its eventful history of 49 years has taken long strides in spreading the message of Guru Nanak Dev Ji and promoting education in fields such as Sciences, Social Science, Languages, Humanities, Arts, Management, Engineering and Technology, Environment, Planning, Architecture and comparative religion. No. 74-2/2018 (DEB-I) dated 18-10-2018 (*attached below*) and F.No. 1-8-2017 (CPP-II) "Categorization of Universities (Only) for Grant of Graded Autonomy Regulations, 2018" dated 12th Feb 2018, Guru Nanak Dev University has been categorized as 'Category-I University'. Guru Nanak Dev University, being Category-I University, has been given the privilege to run Open & Distance Programme without seeking permissions from UGC as per the below-given notification:

As per clause 4.10 of UGC (Categorization of University (Only) for grant of graded Autonomy) Regulation, 2018, for Category-I Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs):

"University may offer courses in the open and distance learning mode, without the approval of the commission, provided it satisfies all the conditions laid down under UGC (ODL) Regulation, 2017 and its amendments and norms issued by statutory bodies/councils from time to time"

Under this provision and with the permissions from DEB-UGC, New Delhi, and different academic bodies of University (*Academic Council, Senate & Syndicate*), the Directorate of Open and Distance Learning, Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar was established in the year 2018 in the main campus of GNDU, Amritsar. As per the provisions under the ODL programme, new programmes have been introduced in the University, its Regional Campuses, and its Colleges (*both University and it's Constituent*) w.e.f. Session 2019-20, the Directorate is offering 10 different courses in areas of Arts, Humanities, Business Management, Commerce and Computers, etc.

Some Highlights/Milestones achieved by the Directorate during the Session 2019-20

- In the previous session 2019-20, there was 2-3 fold increment in the number of candidates and a total of 389 fresh candidates took admission in different courses offered by the Directorate.
